

TIARO FIELD DAY 1ST AUGUST 2026 – TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR VENDORS

1. The Tiaro Field Day (TFD) committee reserves the right to refuse any vendor booking. Preference will be given to local business/community groups.
2. Sites will be allocated by the committee. Vendors MUST use the site allocated to them on day. If you have special requirements for your products or services, please advise at time of booking.
3. Vehicles are not allowed within the exhibition area between 9am – 3pm (Vehicles to be clear of site by 8.00am). If your vehicle is necessary for your display and won't fit on your 3x3m site, you will require an extra site. **THIS INCLUDES NOT DRIVING ON OR OFF THE TFD SITE DURING THE HOURS OF OPERATION 9am to 3pm. PEDESTRIAN & VEHICULAR TRAFFIC MUST BE KEPT SEPARATE DURING ALL OPERATIONAL TIMES.** THE ONLY EXCPEITION IS EMERGENCY VEHICLES WHICH WILL BE PROVIDED WITH A 4-POINT TFD OFFICIALS ESCORT (“spotters”).
4. Stalls must not be pulled down prior to 3.00pm. (if sold out, stalls can be tied up/closed ready for pull down).
5. Vendors MUST comply with all Workplace Health and Safety regulations as per WHS QLD Legislation and Landcare Policy/Procedures.
6. The vendor occupies and uses the site at their own risk, indemnifying the organising committee and the TFD from any liability for any damage to the display, stall, or any other property of any description; insurance is the responsibility of the vendor.
7. Vendors should carry a public liability policy (\$5 Million Minimum) to cover their involvement at the Field Day. A copy of the public liability policy must be provided at time of booking.
8. All food vendors must meet the Food Safety Standards under the Food Hygiene Regulations issued by the Department of Health and Fraser Coast Regional Council food license requirements.
9. Certified & Registered Assistance Dogs ONLY allowed on site unless exemption has been approved by the organising committee.
10. All Electrical equipment must be tested and tagged and must be in date at time of the event. Non-compliant or unsafe leads will be disconnected and removed.
11. All vendors must provide a Risk Assessment for their stall/activity at time of booking.
12. Plants listed as Declared Pest or Restricted Plants under the Queensland government Land Protections Act or listed as an Environmental Weeds by the Fraser Coast Regional Council cannot be offered for sale.
13. Signs are allowed within the boundaries of your allocated space and must relate to the products/services you are displaying or selling. The organisers reserve the right to request the removal of any inappropriate signage or signage that constitutes a trip or other safety hazard, etc.
14. You are required to notify the organisers if you plan on setting up your own PA or sound system to use on your site at any time during the Field Day.
15. The event will proceed unless an extreme weather event occurs. No refunds will be made if the event is cancelled due to weather conditions.
16. DO NOT SEND ANY PAYMENT WITH APPLICATION. Upon booking confirmation, successful applicants will be invoiced.
17. Any bookings received after 18 July 2026 will be placed on a waiting list and notified if a place becomes available. BOOKINGS NOT MADE THROUGH THE VENDOR COORDINATOR ARE NOT VALID.
